## NOTICE REGARDING ELECTION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEMBER

To: All Police Officer Members of the Retirement System

Pursuant to the Act governing the Austin Police Retirement System (Article 6243n-1, V.T.C.S., as amended effective September 1, 2013), an election is to be held to elect **two** active police officer members of the Board of Trustees, for a term of four years. Each candidate must be an active member of the System; eligibility to serve will be verified by a computer listing of active members.

Active police officer members of the System who wish to have their names placed on the electronic ballot as a candidate must submit to the Election Committee a written Statement of Interest to serve on the Board. **That Statement of Interest must be received by the Election Committee no later than October 22, 2013**, and must include the following:

1. Name;
2. A brief personal statement of reasons for wanting to serve on the Board.

A candidate may, but is not required to, include a photo for publication. The Statement of Interest should be mailed or delivered to the Election Committee in care of the Chief Executive Officer at the address shown below. Anyone mailing a Statement of Interest should do so promptly, in order to insure that it is received by the deadline.

Please note that this year's election will be conducted by electronic balloting. Please watch for communication from VR Election Services in mid-November so that you do not miss instructions on how to cast your vote.
